

# Collection Schedules

Trash, yard debris roll carts, and disposable bags will be collected weekly on the designated day for your collection zone. Recyclables are collected every other week on the zone's designated day. In 2025, recycling will begin the week of January 1st. Limbs, cuttings, and shrubbery will be collected bi-weekly, opposite of recycling weeks. The modified schedule of city-observed holidays is located on the back of this brochure. ## Accommodations

The City offers accommodations for residents with disabilities, special needs, or elderly with a note from a medical provider. These accommodations may be made by calling 843.383.3006.

## Special Item Pickup

Furniture, including but not limited to, box springs, mattresses, recliners, tables, dressers, etc. will be collected bi-weekly, opposite of recycling weeks.

Small household items such as toasters, hairdryers, etc. may be placed in the garbage for disposal. Computers, monitors, printers, microwaves, and televisions cannot be placed in the garbage for collection.

# Trash



Small household waste, grocery bags, styrofoam, non-recyclables, toasters, small electronics



Large electronics, deceased animals, leaves, grass clippings, tree trimmings, lumber, stoves, refrigerators, washers, and dryers, oil, antifreeze, or other hazardous waste items

Designated days for the pick up of trash and recyclables are once per week.

Roll carts should be placed at the curb before 7 a.m. on the designated day per the zone collection calendar.

Items over the trash cart capacity or items placed in boxes, bags, or on the ground will not be picked up.

Additional roll carts may be requested for \$8.50 per month.



# Recycling



Aluminum cans, steel cans, milk & juice jugs, plastic bottles, office paper, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, mail, cardboard (dry), paperboard, phone books, other plastics (#1 - #7)



Glass bottles & jars, ceramics, metals, styrofoam, waxed cardboard, shredded paper, grocery bags, other plastic bags, bubble/plastic wrap, juice pouches, aerosol cans

If any non-recyclables are placed in a recycling cart, the cart will not be collected until all unacceptable items are removed by the resident. This includes, but is not limited to rejected recyclables, household trash, and yard waste. Additional roll carts may be requested for \$8.50 per month.



# Yard Debris



Leaves, grass clippings, small tree trimmings, small limbs (3ftx3in)



Household waste, recyclables, non-recyclables, concrete, bricks, rocks, dirt, stumps, construction materials

All loose debris such as leaves, grass clippings, pine straw, etc. shall be enclosed in disposable bags or a city provided container for collection. Yard debris roll carts can be obtained from the sanitation department upon request. Additional roll carts may be requested for \$8.50 per month. Yard debris roll carts and bags will be collected weekly. Limbs, cuttings, shrubbery, etc., are not to exceed three inches in diameter and six feet in length and shall be placed at the front property line for pickup. Limbs, cuttings, and shrubbery will be collected bi-weekly, opposite of recycling weeks.
